The February Almond Industry Position Report also contains the Quality Control Report. Readers will notice that the USDA Certificates for almond receipts on the Quality Control Report exceed the Form 1 Receipts for the period.

This result is a timing difference from the date of the last Form 1 required after December 31, 1994, and the Board's receipt of USDA Incoming Inspection Certificates. Board staff would expect this difference to diminish with the next requisite filing of Form 1 that is due April 5, 1995.
